2012 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

(Application Deadline: March 31, 2012)

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) The applicant must be currently enrolled in a construction related degree program in a university, college, or vocational/trade school in the United States.
- 2) The applicant must be a full time student with a minimum of 12 hours enrollment per semester/trimester/quarter. **High school seniors are not eligible.**
- 3) The applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 (based on a 4.0 system).
- 4) The applicant must submit with the application a copy (scanned or photocopy) of school transcripts through the fall of the previous year.
- 5) Student **members of NAWIC are not eligible** to receive this scholarship.
- 6) Applicants should either be **permanent residents of Iowa, Illinois or Wisconsin** or attend school in one of these states. Proximity to the Quad Cities is desirable but not mandatory.
