Scholarship requirements and information—Please Read Carefully:

1. **Eligibility:**

- a. The applicant must be enrolled in a construction related program at a university, college, or vocational/trade school in the United States.
- b. Applicant must be a full-time student with a minimum of 12 hours enrollment per semester and be enrolled in the Fall 2022 Semester.
- c. NAWIC scholarships are open to both female and male students.
- d. We do not award scholarships to Master's or PhD students.
- e. Student members or children of members of NAWIC Chapter #50 are not eligible for the NAWIC Scholarships.
- f. GPA – Minimum grade point average of 2.75 based on a 4.0 system.
- g. AGC student members *are* eligible to receive the AGC Scholarship.
- h. Applicants need to be permanent residents of Iowa, Illinois or Wisconsin or attend school in one of these states.

2. **What to Submit:**

- a. Transcripts – Submit college your transcripts through Fall Semester 2022.
- b. Completed Application – Submittal should contain proper grammar and be free of spelling errors.
- c. Current Resume

3. **Award Distribution Requirements:**

- a. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the financial aid office of your school and are aligned with your student ID. Funds are to be used for tuition, fees, and on-campus room and board only.
- b. Scholarship funds are awarded based off on the application you submit.
- c. Applicants who are awarded a scholarship are highly encouraged to attend the annual NAWIC Chapter #50 fundraiser that is scheduled to be held on Friday, November 11, 2022 at the Stoney Creek Inn—101 18th Street, Moline, IL, 61265. Donors want to meet and greet the students they support. This event will align with the most current pandemic criteria at the time of the event.

If you have previously applied for this scholarship, you MUST answer a different question from prior submissions for your second question. Essay should be no more than one page in length and should be single spaced.

Required Question and Additional Questions

1. Why did you choose this course of study?
- A. What has been your most important extracurricular activity, your most important contribution to it, and what has your participation meant to you as an individual?
- B. What event(s) in your life led you to this course of study?
- C. What effect on your education would this scholarship have if you're selected?
- D. Describe areas in your life where you have demonstrated leadership and overcome obstacles either through school, social, or family life.
- E. What are the most important issues the construction industry is facing today?
- F. If you have done a mission trip, study abroad program or lived in another country how has it influenced your goals, values, attitudes or perceptions?
- G. Describe a personal influence who has led you to the construction field.
- H. What attributes, qualities or skills are you most proud of? How did you develop them?
