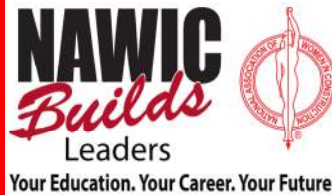

NAWIC BLOCK KIDS CONTEST

It's building time again! This popular program, which is sponsored by the Quad City Chapter 50 National Association of Women in Construction, encourages participants to look for creative solutions to construction challenges. Participants will receive 100 plastic building blocks, a piece of string, a small rock, and a piece of aluminum foil to create a building project in 30 minutes. The entrants will be judged by members of the Quad Cities building community. The project chosen by the judges as the most noteworthy will be entered in a regional contest. Winners at the regional level will then be entered in a national contest.

Pre-registration is strongly recommended, but if there are openings or cancellations, registrations will be taken the morning of the event. There is no fee to register. The number of applicants is limited to 40 this year, so please register early!

CALLING ALL KIDS IN GRADES 1ST - 6TH

ELIGIBILITY:

This contest is open to ALL children currently enrolled in first through sixth grades, except previous national winners. Prizes are awarded to the top six entrants, but all participants are winners!

GUIDELINES:

All building projects must be:

- Completed where and when designated by NAWIC Sponsor Chapter;
- Completed within the allotted time;
- Completed using approved materials only;
- Be relative to the construction industry. Projects which depict people or animals will not be allowed;
- Completed by entrant with no outside assistance from parents, teachers or other people;
- Every participant must submit the Official Registration/Entry Form, signed by a parent or guardian;
- All registrations must be completed by 10:00 am;
- All participants must be at their building site by 10:00 am.

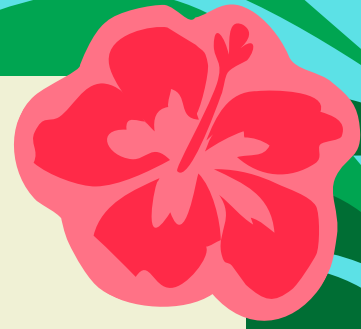

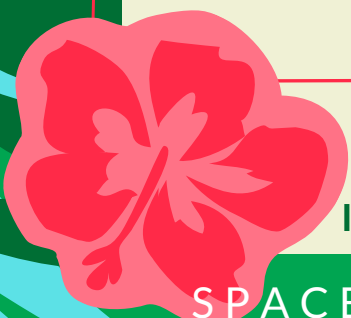
